

Cell Phone Rules

1. Cell phones are to be turned **OFF**, not seen or heard by staff from the time students walk into Hersey High School until 2:50 PM.
2. The exception to this rule is during a Designated Time **AND** in a Designated Cell Phone Area.
3. The Designated Times for cell phone usage are:
 - a. BEFORE 7:25 AM
 - b. On Orange Late Start days until 8:15 AM
 - c. During each student's assigned lunch period
4. The Designated Cell Phone Areas are in the cafeteria and the commons area (where the vending machines and circle tables are located). The commons area does NOT include any area beyond the steps entering the commons hallway.

****Cell phones are never allowed to be used, seen or heard from the time a student walks into the building until 2:50 PM in classrooms, hallways, restrooms, gymnasiums, or locker rooms.***

Substance Abuse Policy

Students who violate the District 214 Substance Abuse Policy may lose privileges including: open lunch, open study, enrollment in the behind the wheel component of Drivers' Education, classes where heavy machinery is operated, campus parking, and/or overnight field trips and excursions.

Reclassified Students lose the privilege of an Open Lunch

In the 2015-16 school year, students who are reclassified due to a lack of credits will lose their open lunch privileges. This will be enforced regardless of the student's year in school. In order for students to regain open lunch privileges, they must demonstrate efforts to remediate their academic situations, shown by passing all classes the following semester without major disciplinary incidents. If the student does not continue to pass all classes, or has a major disciplinary incident, the lunch will again be closed.
