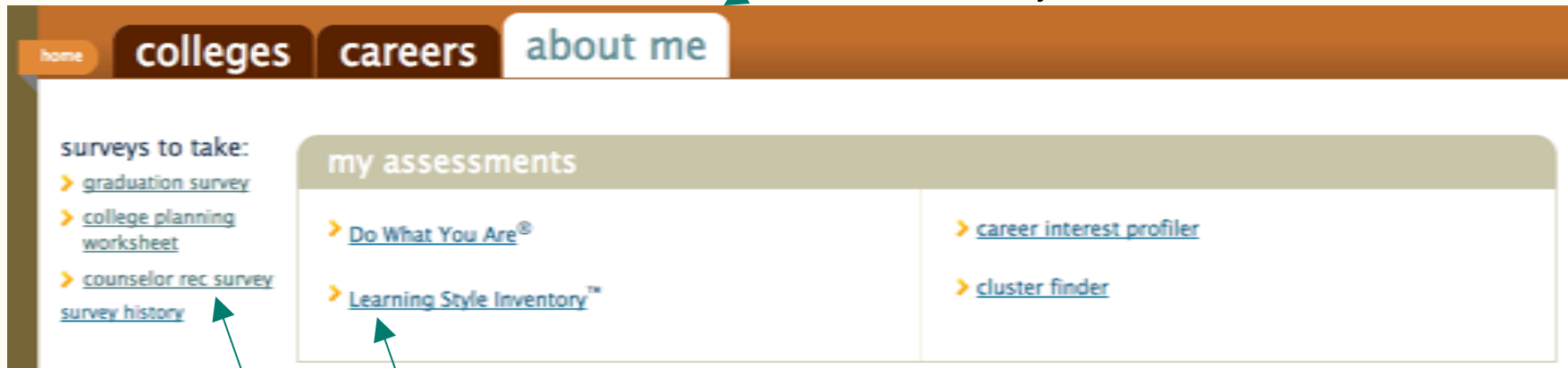

This tab includes surveys to be taken and different assessments to learn more about yourself.




This will help your counselor write a great letter of recommendation for your colleges.

This section saves things you want to remember like your favorite careers, colleges or long term game plan.

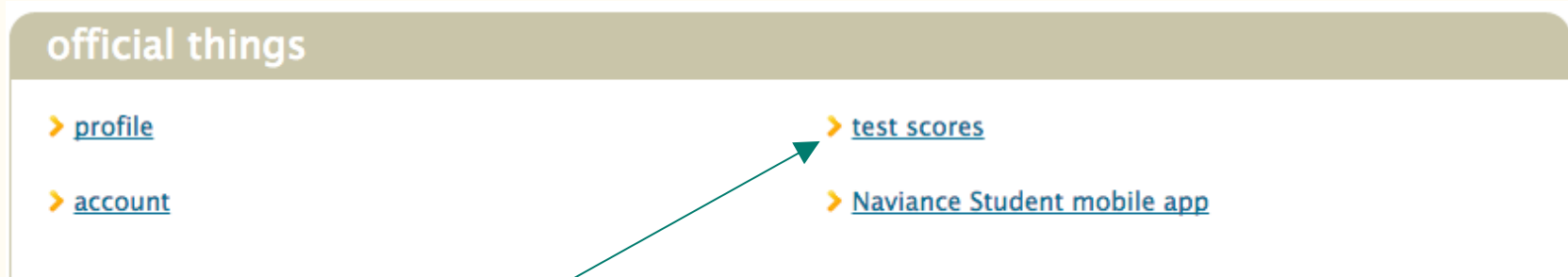

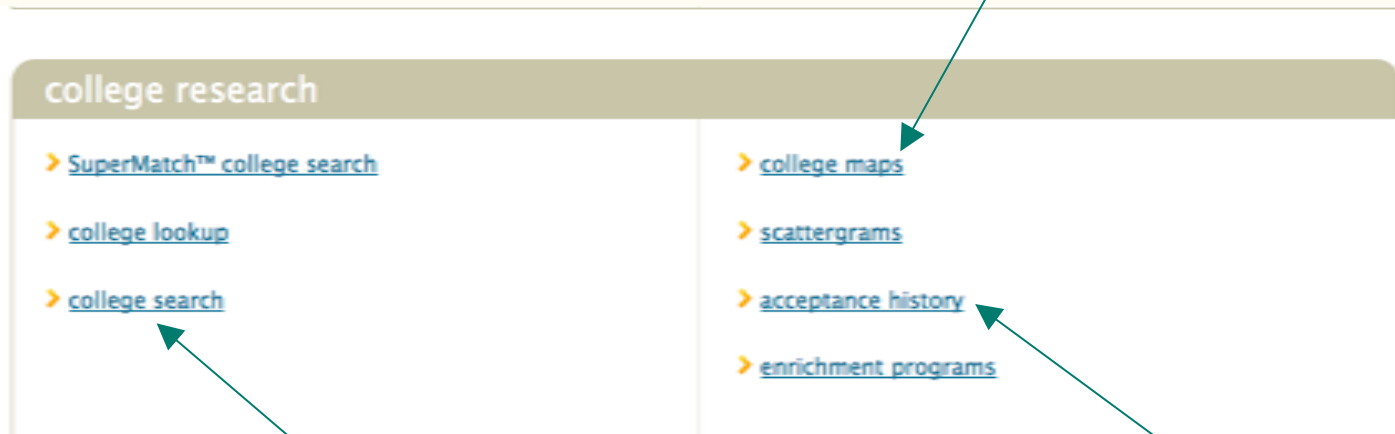

The college research section has great tools to identifying colleges that match your interests



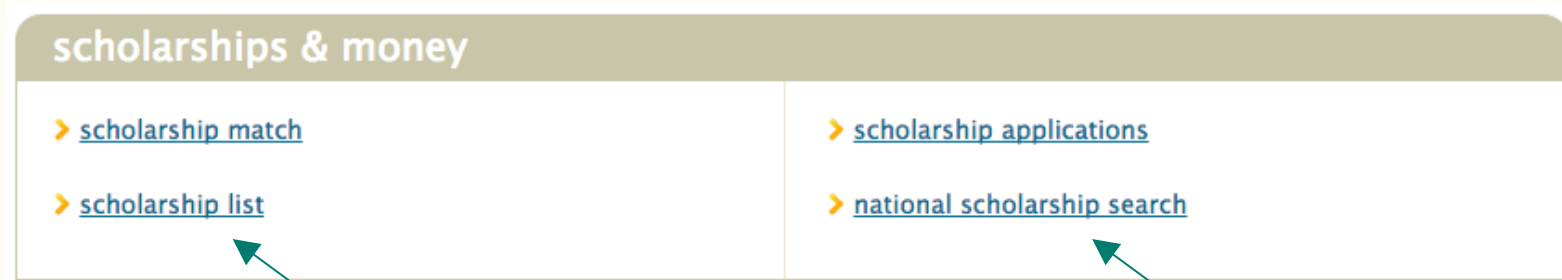
In here, zoom in on a US map to plan college visits.
