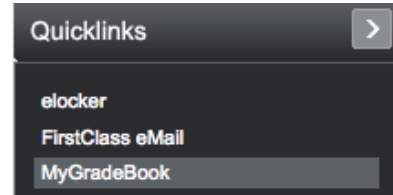


MyGradebook.com Guide for Parents

After you connect to the Internet, there are two quick options for connecting to MGB:

- Go to the JHHS Home Page (<http://jhhs.d214.org/>) and click on the MGB link located in the Quicklinks on the RMHS homepage.

To access your student's records in MGB you will need a "CLASSWORD" and "PASSWORD" which will be provided by to your student by their 2nd period teacher.

Please note: if you have a returning student, the previous school year (2008-09) MGB classword and password has been deactivated. Parents and students **must** use the current 2009-10 classword and password to access their grades.

Please refer to the following instructions as a guide for accessing your student's grades:

What you do ...	What the computer does ...
<p>Enter the "Classword" in the top blank of the login window. Enter the "Password" in the bottom blank of the login window. Then click "submit."</p> <p><i>Helpful Hint:</i> If you don't know student classword/password, ASK YOUR STUDENT'S SEMINAR TEACHER!</p>	
<p>Your student's seminar class will display at the top of the class list. Note: Your student does NOT earning a grade in seminar.</p>	
<p>Choose the desired class and grading period from the list of active classes displayed on the MGB screen</p>	
<p>To learn more details, about your student's assignments click on the assignment tab located at the top of the screen.</p>	
<p>When you are finished reviewing your student's progress, click the logoff link</p>
