## Art 1 (#101)

Do you like to express yourself visually? Do you want to develop and improve your artistic talent in high school? If so register for Art One, Hersey's entry-level art course, which leads directly to advanced classes. This year long course directs students in the creative process and builds their technical skills necessary for developing their artistic ability. A wide variety of art media is introduced during the study of drawing, printmaking, painting, sculpture, jewelry and computer imaging. This course satisfies the District 214 Fine Arts Requirement.

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## Art Survey (#125)

Do you want to experiment with learning how to draw, paint, and work in three-dimensional materials such as plaster and metal? Art Survey is a semester long course which offers experiences in a variety of media. The course begins by introducing the fundamentals of drawing and design. After covering these introductory skills, the course will move on to explorations in painting, sculpture, and jewelry. This course satisfies the District 214 Fine Arts Requirement.
