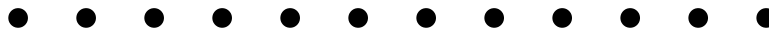
Journalistic Writing 1* (#311) & 2 (#312)

Enroll in Journalistic Writing as an entry into the school journalism program. Freshmen are welcome to register for this course that gets them started in the school print and online media that can be continued in the second semester by enrolling in #312. Students will learn how to get people reading their stories through writing entertainment, sports, opinion, news, and feature pieces as well as learning to design pages and posting on Correspondentlive.com.
