Yearbook 1 introduces students to active involvement in creating the school yearbook. Students learn to apply principles of publishing, write for publication, and produce the yearbook through a variety of projects. During the year that continues with Yearbook 2, students will plan, design, copyright, edit, photograph, and produce the yearbook. Class periods involve training sessions and actual working sessions, which apply skills and contribute to the production of the yearbook.
